Academic Excellence and Exceptional Outcomes

Stephen Perse Cambridge consistently achieves top results in GCSEs and A levels. Students progress to leading universities, as well as elite conservatoires and art schools. UK destinations include the universities of Oxford and Cambridge (7% of Sixth Form leavers in 2025), Imperial College London, the Russell Group institutions, Guildhall School of Music and Drama, and sought after degree apprenticeships, whilst overseas our students progress to universities including Princeton, Stanford, Toronto, Amsterdam, Sciences Po, Heidelberg and Hong Kong.
