KINDNESS AND RESPECT

LEARNING

I will engage in lessons and behave in a way that promotes effective learning.	I will show respect by listening to staff members and other pupils at all times.	I will complete my work to the best of my abilities and ask my teacher for help when I need it.	I will take responsibility for my organisation. If I need help with my organisation I will speak to my teacher.
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PREVENTION OF BULLYING

I understand that bullying of any type, whether it is emotional, cyber-bullying, verbal or physical, is unacceptable.	I will not behave in a way that makes anyone around me feel excluded or intimidated.	If I experience bullying, I will tell a member of staff I feel comfortable with or my parents.	If I know of someone being bullied I will tell an adult.
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SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

I will treat school property with respect and keep all learning spaces and changing rooms tidy.	I will only use property that is my own and not take other items, including iPads, without permission.	I understand that bags, trays and personal possessions are private property and should be treated as such.	I will take pride in my surroundings and not litter or graffiti in school or beyond.
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TECHNOLOGY

I will only use my iPad in school with the permission of a staff member.	I will follow the Acceptable Use Policy at all times.	I will only use technology to engage in educational activities during the school day.	I will use my iPad respectfully; I will only take photos, make recordings or share materials with others' permission.
